HOW TO USE THIS PRAYER MAP

I encourage you to use this prayer map regularly in the following ways:

1. Pray for you own Nation- Example- Pray for Unity among the Pastors and that they will have not only a message for the lost but a heart for them as well. Pray that we are always directed by the Holy Spirit.

Pray for Homes & Families, The Economy, The Government, The Education System, The Justice System.

Pray for your leaders to serve with integrity and high moral standards. Pray for the Churches to unite and work together!

2. Pray for the Nations of the Caribbean- A list of the Countries, Head of State and Population size is included. Pray for Open hands, Open Doors, Open Minds, Open Hearts and Open Heavens.

3. Pray for 5 persons to get saved. (see pick 5 at the top right corner of the prayer map).

4. Prayer for a specific church need (see my church needs at the top left corner of the prayer map).

5. Pray for 3 personal needs (see three things I am believing God for on the bottom right of the prayer map).

Can prayer make a difference? Yes, it most certainly can!
