

Camp Rules:

1. Camp Rules must be observed by all attending and participating in Camp activities.
2. All Campers must participate in Chapel, lectures, and group sessions.
3. The Camp committee will ensure that deportment, dress, and courtesy of campers be kept up to standard at all times.
4. All campers and leaders must observe a high standard of discipline.
5. No Camper is allowed outside the camp compound without written permission of the Camp Director.
6. Areas that are declared "out of bounds" are off limits to all campers at all times.
7. No knives or weapons of any kind allowed on the compound.
8. All Campers should exercise care concerning the safety and security of their personal belongings.
9. Interfering with or stealing the personal belongings of other campers is strictly prohibited.
10. All lights will be turned off at 11:00 P.M except for designated areas.
11. No smoking, alcohol or use of illicit drugs including marijuana.
12. Fighting is strictly prohibited.
13. The use of obscene language is strictly prohibited.
14. Disrespect for leaders will not be tolerated.
15. Any unruly or suggestive behaviour between different sexes or same sex will not be tolerated, at any time. Such as:
 - ❖ Kissing
 - ❖ love making
 - ❖ fondling
 - ❖ sitting on lap
 - ❖ Sexual interaction or advance
 - ❖ any behaviour that would be considered as sexual.
16. Defacing and damaging of any equipment or material found on the camp site is strictly prohibited. The camper will be required to pay the cost of the damage.
17. The bellwhistle shall be obeyed promptly.
18. All campers are expected to be punctual for all occasions.
19. No Headsets allowed.
20. There will be ABSOLUTELY NO MUSHING (pasting with powder, toothpaste or otherwise) allowed.

DRESS CODE:

We must not forget that this is a Christian Camp, therefore, all campers are expected to dress themselves in modest apparel. Our interpretation of modest is:

- ✓ Excessively tight clothing is not allowed.
- ✓ Vest should not be worn at Chapel or Lecture sessions (male and female)
- ✓ Transparent and revealing tops must not be worn (e.g. vests, shirts, blouses etc.)
- ✓ Short pants must be no shorter than four inches above the knees (male and female)
- ✓ Tights allowed for physical activities only.
- ✓ No halter backs for females.
- ✓ All tops worn must cover the top of pants or skirt waist.

Failure to comply with these rules and the Dress Code will result in Disciplinary action as seen fit by the Camp Committee.
