Christmas is about worship; today, just as it was on that first Christmas morning in Bethlehem. The very foundation of our Christmas celebration is worship. Worship in the Christmas story is characterized by diverse forms of adoration, including singing, praising, and giving.

The angel who heralded the message to the shepherds on that morn in Bethlehem, were joined by a host of angels saying, "Glory to God in the highest." When the shepherds themselves found the baby, they returned "glorifying and praising God." Zechariah, the priest who begun in doubt, sang praise after he saw God's miraculous plan unfolding and was filled with the Spirit and prophesied, "Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel." Mary sang the Magnificat, a song of praise and joy, after her cousin Elizabeth greeted her with, "My soul glorifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior." Simeon praised God in the temple after holding the infant Jesus saying, "Sovereign Lord, as you have pvromised, you may now dismiss your servant in peace." Anna the prophetess when she discovered the child also sang praise to God. The Magi took the dangerous trek from Babylon to Bethlehem with the compelling motive, "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him." When they found the child, they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

Christmas represents the greatest expression of the unconditional love of God the world has ever known. And when the manger of Bethlehem is joined to the cross of Golgotha the result is God offering the free gift of eternal life to all who would receive it.






On behalf of the Barbados District my prayer is that you have a culturally rich Caribbean Christmas and a new year powered by God's purpose and enriched with His presence.


