About Global Missions Centre

Located at 231 Eastern Main Road, El Dorado, Global Missions Centre is part of PAWI's North East Trinidad District. The assembly is committed to prayer, biblical preaching, discipleship, pastoral care and community engagement. This appointment calls for a pastor who can strengthen people and ministries, develop leaders, work constructively with the Church Board and District Executive, and provide clear direction for healthy growth.

Main Responsibilities

- Prioritise prayer and the preaching and teaching of Scripture.
- Provide spiritual oversight, counselling, visitation and pastoral care.
- Make disciples, develop leaders and equip members for ministry.
- Set direction for church health, growth, outreach and ministry development.
- Oversee services, ministries, governance and responsible stewardship of resources.
- Build constructive relationships with the congregation, District and community.

Essential Criteria

- A current PAWI credential at LTM or higher in good standing and eligibility to serve as a PAWI pastor.
- Consistent Christian character, sound doctrine and conduct appropriate to spiritual leadership, including the qualities described in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:5-9.
- At least five years of pastoral or comparable ministry leadership experience, with evidence of effective service.
- Formal theological education from the West Indies School of Theology or another recognised Bible or theological institution, normally at diploma level or above.
- Demonstrated competence in preaching, teaching, discipleship, pastoral care and leader development.
- Ability to lead people, work with a Church Board, manage conflict and provide strategic direction.
- Full acceptance of PAWI doctrine, governance and District relationships, with sound administrative and financial judgement.

Desirable Criteria

- A bachelor's degree in theology, ministry or a related field.
- Appointment as a Marriage Officer in Trinidad and Tobago, or eligibility to pursue appointment.
- Evidence of effective leadership in church growth, community engagement, leadership development, ministry renewal, governance or financial stewardship.

Remuneration

The package will follow applicable PAWI and District pastoral guidelines and will be discussed with shortlisted candidates.

- A cover letter stating your interest and suitability for the appointment.
- A current resume outlining education, ministry experience, leadership responsibilities and areas of gifting.
- Copies of current PAWI credentials and relevant academic or professional qualifications.
- Two written references from ordained PAWI or Full Gospel ministers who can speak to your character, ministerial standing and leadership experience.
- If you currently serve outside the North East Trinidad District, a written recommendation or confirmation of good standing from your Presiding Bishop.

The process may include interviews with the District Executive and Church Board and presentation to the congregation, in accordance with PAWI's Constitution, Bylaws and Policy and Procedural Manual.

The District Office will acknowledge applications in writing within five days. Only shortlisted candidates will be invited to interview. Candidate information will be handled confidentially.
